

Overview

With the redevelopment of Australian Taekwondo (AT) NCAS Coach Education framework, some coaches who were accredited in the former system may be able to transition their accreditation to the new framework.

The AT Kyorugi Coaching Committee has decided that a **Recognition of Current Competency** process will be available for eligible coaches to receive the AT NCAS Club Talent Coach accreditation.

Recognition of Current Competency (RCC) applies if someone has previously successfully completed the requirements for an accreditation and makes an application to be assessed to ascertain that the competence has been maintained.

* Please note that Australian Taekwondo is waiving the administration fee for the processing of an RCC application until June 2017 when this RCC process concludes.

The application process

Step 1 – Am I eligible?

Coaches are eligible to apply for RCC for an AT NCAS Club Talent Coach accreditation by providing the following information:

- Current financial membership of Australian Taekwondo
- Have previously held (with in the last 4 years) a Level 1 or Level 2 Taekwondo Coaching Accreditation
- A Working With Children Check (or state equivalent eg Blue card)
- First Aid qualification\
- Currently coaching (2016) in a registered AT Club
- 50 hours of coaching in 2016
- A signed AT Coaches Code of Behaviour

Step 2 – I can provide all that information so what do I do next?

- o Complete ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping Online training course

- o Complete the ASC Play By The Rules Online course
