

# **Community Club of the Year**

Nomination & Selection Criteria

## AWARD DESCRIPTION

This award recognises a community club who has enthusiastically worked to connect more people to Taekwondo, positively promote social inclusion in Taekwondo that is non-discriminatory, and provide a safe and encouraging club culture. This award is presented to one club each year.

## NOMINATION TYPE

This award is peer nominated and is open for nomination by any current Australian Taekwondo affiliated club and their respective members.

# NOMINEE ELIGIBILITY

- A financial member club of Australian Taekwondo for the current season
- The club has not been subject to any sanctions and/or suspensions by Australian Taekwondo during the current season.
- The club is fully compliant with Australian Taekwondo's governance requirements

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

#### This information is what the nomination will be assessed on and is a critical part of the review process.

- Evidence of how the club is Connecting Everybody to Taekwondo by creating positive, inclusive experiences for anyone who wants to participate.
- Evidence of how the club is engaging and empowering women and girls as participants and leaders at their club.
- Evidence of how the club ensures good governance practices and promoting a safe club culture.
- Evidence of how the club has implemented a participation program such as Taekwondo Kickstarters, Para-Taekwondo, Fighting Falls, Women's Self Defence etc
- Any additional information to support the nomination.

#### SELECTION PROCESS

Nominations will be assessed against the above selection criteria. Consultation with the relevant state association/s may be required before recommendation to the Australian Taekwondo Board for approval.
