3. Requirements for participation

- Holder of World Taekwondo Global License.
- Applicant aged 18 years or above.
- To apply as a:

Medical Classifier: must have Taekwondo-specific knowledge and/or certified medical. professional in a field relevant to the impairment category that WT, at its sole discretion, deems acceptable as detailed in the Athlete Classification Rules (e.g., physicians and physiotherapists for athletes with physical impairment).

Technical Classifier: must have extensive coaching or other relevant backgrounds in the sport of Taekwondo, e.g. sport science or sport-specific expertise, which WT at its sole discretion deems to be acceptable.

4. Registration process

- Registration through GMS - <https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/login>. (Infographics attached for details)
- Applicants can register for **Level II Classifier (International K40)** Certification courses at the same time with a special rate.
- Once registered **PLEASE SEND YOUR C.V.** to para-tkd@worldtaekwondo.org.

5. Registration Fees

- **ONLY Level I Classifier (National)** certification course **300 US\$**.
- **Both Level I Classifier (National)** and **Level II Classifier (International K40)** Certification courses **500 US\$ (special rate, done through offline payment bank transfer only)**.

6. Payment method

Option 1: Online Payment Instruction

- If applying for this course **ONLY**, applicant can pay directly online by credit/debit card at the time of registration.
- If the applicant wishes to pay online at a later time but before the deadline, applicant can log in back at any time to their own personal "**GMS profile**", go to "**Courses**", find the course and click on "**PAY**" button to pay online by credit/debit card.

Option 2: Offline Payment Instruction

7. Certification

- **Level I** course is **THEORATICAL** in nature.
- Attendance to all lectures is mandatory followed by an online written multiple-choice test through GMS.
- Participants who have successfully passed the course (at least 70% score) will be granted a World Para Taekwondo **Level I Classifier (National)** certificate, issued online through GMS.
- Participants will then be eligible to proceed to **Level II Classifier (International K40)**.

8. Learning Outcomes

- The IPC and World Para Taekwondo rules, regulations, and codes of conduct.
- General Para Taekwondo sport classes and sport class status.
- Roles and responsibilities of athlete, coach, and classifiers in the classification process.
- Para Taekwondo medical and technical terminology.
- How to interpret the medical diagnostic form.
- What is the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) and how to use it.
- Classifiers tools and how to set up the classification room.
- General medical and technical assessments of sport classes, particularly K40.
- Observation assessment procedure and allocation of sport classes & sport class status.
- Filling in the classifier notes in a championship

9. Failure to Pass the Examination

- Candidates who fail the online test (less than 70%) will be allowed to attend **ONLY** the next available course free of charge, .
- Candidates who registered and paid for both **Level I** & **level II**, their payment for **Level II** will be reserved, however, they will not be allowed to attend **Level II** until they pass **Level I**.
