QUALIFICATION

In accordance with Article 4 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

1. Holder of Nationality of the participating team
 - 1.1 Athletes with a refugee status issued by either governmental authorities in the country of residence or the UNHCR may be entered into tournaments and championships under WT flag based on prior approval from WT.
2. An athlete recommended by a WT recognized Member National Association
3. Holder of a WT recognized Dan or 5-1 Geup / Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued by the WT or MNA recognized A-class (Dan Division) and B-Class (Geup Division 4th Geup -1st Geup) for Poomsae events.
4. Holder of a WT Global Athlete Licence
5. Kyrogui Contestant shall be at least 16 years old in the year of the pertinent tournament.
6. Poomsae contestants shall be at least 17 years old in the year of the pertinent tournament. Senior I (18-30 yrs), Senior II (31yrs and older).
7. Athlete must go through International Classification in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament. Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) or with a Classification Not Complete (CNC) will not be able to compete.

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Administration regulations of International Para Taekwondo Coaches, all coaches officiating at the 2023 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships needs to be a certified World Para Taekwondo International Coach Level 2.

NOTE: Only coaches with a World Para Taekwondo International Coach Certificate Level 2 will be allowed to coach athletes at the 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships.

TEAM DOCTOR/PHYSICIAN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive accreditation as team doctor/physician, all doctors and physicians must attend the medical meeting on September 20, 2023.

COMPETITION RULES AND COMPETITION FORMAT

Kyorugi K40 Sport Class

The latest updated World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be implemented for competition in the K41 and K44 Sport Classes at the 2023 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships.

Competitions will be held in a single elimination format with a one round duration of contest.

*NOTE that Article 10.5 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail weigh-in shall be **disqualified**. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight category by the registration deadline. **Weight categories will not be changed in the case the athlete does not pass weigh-in!**

Poomsae Sport Classes

The latest updated World Para Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules will be implemented for competition in the Poomsae Sport Classes at the 2023 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships.

Article 9.1 will be used for competition for All Sport Classes there is a free choice to athletes to choose (1)Poomsae from Group 1 and (1)Poomsae from Group 2 for each round.

All P30 athletes will be assigned an "R", review Sport Class Status, and must go through classification again at their first tournament under the new World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification Rules. It is essential that a new MDF be submitted to the WTCS no later than registration deadline of the 2023 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships

For the P20 Sport Class, Virtus International Eligibility is still recognized. A new system for eligibility will be introduced. There will be an "MDF" for P20. IQ test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If AAI is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too. MDF and IQ test, AAI is required to be uploaded to the WTCS.

METHOD OF COMPETITION

Kyorugi K40 Sport Class

The Competitions in the K41 and K44 Sport Classes at the 2023 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships will be held in single elimination tournament system.

The duration of contest shall be one round of five (5) minutes with thirty seconds (30) timeout for each athlete. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the five (5) minute round, round of one (1) minute will be conducted as the Golden round, after a one (1) minute rest period. No timeout can be taken during the Golden Round.

Each coach will be allowed to call for one (1) one (1) minute timeout at any time during the one round contest.

The duration of contest may be adjusted to four (4) minutes or three (3) minutes upon the decision of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent Championships.

Win by Point Gap (PTG) 30 points will be implemented throughout the championships.

LICENCE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

WT Global License Registration

All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a valid **2023** WT License. You will not be able to register without renewing the license for **2023!**

WT Online Registration

National Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS administrators will be notified via email once online registration is open.

Registration instructions

Kyorugi - athletes that have already been classified should register in the sport class and weight category where they wish to compete. Athletes that have previously not gone through (New “N”) athlete classification and been assigned a sport class and a sport class status shall register in the desired weight category but in the K40 Sport Class.

Poomsae – athletes should enter in the correct impairment type and sport class in the age (Senior 1 or Senior 2) and belt category (A-class or B-Class).

Unilateral Amputation, through or above wrist (i.e., no carpal bones present in affected limb). Arthrodesis of the wrist joints are Not Eligible (NE).

Unilateral Dysmelia, the length of the affected arm measured from acromion to longest part of the stump is equal in length or shorter than the unaffected arm measured from acromion to radial styloid.

Bilateral Amputation, below the elbow but above or through wrists (NO carpal bones present in either wrists).

Bilateral Dysmelia, the length of each arm is equal to or shorter than $\leq 0.337 \times$ standing height. Only one arm can meet the criteria.


Unilateral or Bilateral Impaired muscle power (Grade 2 muscle power or below) in shoulder abduction and/or flexion.

Unilateral or Bilateral Impaired muscle power (Grade 3 muscle power or below) in elbow flexion and/or extension.

Unilateral or Bilateral Elbow flexion contracture from arthrodesis/ankylosis of a joint with traumatic soft tissue loss or bony joint damage; affected arm length is measured from acromion to longest finger is shorter than or equal to \leq the unaffected arm measured from acromion to radial styloid with the elbow extended passively to the longest.

INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE CLASSIFICATION

The term “Classification” refers to a structure for Competition to ensure that an Athlete’s Impairment is relevant to sport performance, and that Athletes compete equitably with each other. The purpose of Classification is to define who is eligible to compete in Para Taekwondo and to group athletes in sports classes for competition in Kyorugi.

MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC FORM (MDF) for K40, P20, P30, P50 & P70

The Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) is to be completed in English by the athlete’s individual physician or physio therapist.

The completed form must be submitted a **September 6, 2023** before the athlete undergoes athlete evaluation. This applies to all athletes with a physical impairment competing in WT. Depending on the athlete’s health condition and impairment, additional medical information is to be attached to this form (see page 2). Please consult the WT Classification rules for a list of eligible impairments and underlying health conditions for Kyorugi and Poomsae.

There will be separate MDFs for K40, P20, P30, P50, P70

For the P20 Sport Classes a new system for eligibility will be introduced. There will be an "MDF" for P20. IQ test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If AAI is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too.

NOTE – Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a “Classification Not Complete”, “CNC”. The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.



WORLD TAEKWONDO CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM (WTCS)

All athletes previously classified in the P30 Sport Classes with a Confirmed "C" Sport Class Status will revert back to a Review "R" Sport Class Status and will have to be seen again in classification following the update to the World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification Rules to take place during the summer of 2023.

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WT Classification Evaluation Group in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

**WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.*

Virtus Classification System P20 Sport Class

Intellectually Impaired (II) athletes require Virtus International Eligibility as seen on the Virtus Master list <https://www.virtus.sport/eligibility-master-list>.

For the P20 Sport Class, Virtus International Eligibility is still recognized. A new system for eligibility will be introduced. There will be an "MDF" for P20. IQ test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If AAI is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too. MDF and IQ test, AAI will need to be uploaded to the WTCS.

CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE & LOCATION

Classification schedule will be sent out following close of registration. Classification will take place on September 20-21 2023, September 20 for Poomsae athletes and September 21 for Kyorugi athletes. Please ensure to book your tickets so that teams will be in Veracruz both days. Changes to classification schedule will not be made once announced.

GUIDELINES FOR INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE CLASSIFICATION

The athlete should be wearing sport clothes (track suit). The athlete also needs to bring their uniform (dobok) and all personal protective equipment. The athlete should also bring any relevant medical information to classification.

Teams should have with them a translator who has good understanding of English.

The athlete should always do their best on the tests and exercises requested by the International Classifiers.

GLOBAL RANKING

The 2023 10th World Para Taekwondo Championships will hold a World Para Taekwondo **G14** ranking status. Competitions will be held in the Kyorugi “K”, K41 and K44 Sport Classes in five (5) men’s and five (5) women’s weight categories and Poomsae “P”, P21-23, P31-35, P51-53 and P72 sport classes.

In accordance with Article 6.4 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, “all competitions recognized by WT shall be formed with participation of no less than three (3) countries. Official results from Para Taekwondo Competitions with less than three (3) countries participating shall not be recognized by WT. **Any Sport Class and weight category, age or belt division with less than three (3) athletes from two (2) countries shall not be recognized in the official results.**

In accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules article 7.1 recognized medal events shall have at least two competitors from two countries.

WEIGH-IN

Please note that Article 10.5 of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail weigh-in shall be disqualified. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight division by the end of registration deadline. Weight division will not be changed in the case the athlete does not pass weigh in!

Weigh-in will be held in the venue. Please see the event schedule.

RANDOM WEIGH-IN

Random weigh-in will be held in the morning of each competition day in accordance with the schedule. A set percentage (% to be announced at the head of team meeting) of athletes from each weight category will be randomly drawn and announced in accordance with the event schedule. "Over" weight categories are not subject to random weigh-in.

Random weigh-in lists will be published on the World Para Taekwondo Facebook page each day in accordance with the event schedule.

HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

The Head of Team meeting will be held at 19:00 on September 20, 2023 for the Poomsae Competitions. The Head of Team meeting for the Kyorugi Competitions will be held on September 21, 2023 at 14:00. Each participating team may send two (2) persons to attend the head of team meeting.
