

Referee of the Year Award

Nomination & Selection Criteria

AWARD DESCRIPTION

This award recognises the outstanding contribution of Australian Taekwondo referees. This award is presented to one (1) Kyorugi and one (1) Poomsae referee, male or female.

NOMINATION TYPE

This awards is now nominated by the applicable <u>National Referee Committee</u> (Kyorugi or Poomsae). It is at the discretion of each committee if they choose to establish a award nominations sub-committee to review and assess nominations.

NOMINEE ELIGIBILITY

A referee who is nominated for this award must:

- Be an accredited Australian Taekwondo referee (Kyorugi or Poomsae) and hold a current certification.
- Has refereed at no less than three state, national and/or international events during the current season.
- Has not been sanctioned or suspended by Australian Taekwondo during the current season.

SELECTION CRITERIA

What the nomination is to be assessed and reviewed on.

- How the referee has worked to make a significant difference by demonstrating ethical standards that enhance the environment for athletes, coaches and other referees at domestic events.
- How the referee has contributed towards the development and improvement of other referees.
- How the referee's contribution to Taekwondo has positively impacted the sport and/or the martial art during the season.
- The referee's general performance throughout the season.

SELECTION PROCESS

Nominations will be put forward by the applicable National Referee Committee (Kyorugi or Poomsae) and will be assessed against the above selection criteria before submission to Australian Taekwondo for approval.
